INORGANIC SURGE BASIN
TECHNICALLY COMPLETE SOLID WASTE PERMIT RENEWAL

The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, has determined that Type I Industrial Solid Waste Surface Impoundment Permit Renewal Application for Georgia Gulf Chemical & Vinyls, LLC, Post Office Box 629, Plaquemine, Louisiana 70765-0629 for the Inorganic Surge Basin is technically complete and acceptable for public review. **The facility is located at 26100 River Road, Plaquemine, Iberville Parish.**

Georgia Gulf Chemical & Vinyls, LLC requested a Type I Industrial Solid Waste Permit Renewal for continued operations of the Inorganic Surge Basin. The basin is part of a system that treats storm water and process water generated within the facility.

Written comments, written requests for a public hearing or written requests for notification of the final decision regarding this permit action may be submitted to LDEQ, Public Participation Group, P.O. Box 4313, Baton Rouge, LA 70821-4313. **Written comments and/or written requests must be received by 12:30 p.m., Thursday, May 5, 2011.** Written comments will be considered prior to a final permit decision.

If LDEQ finds a significant degree of public interest, a public hearing will be held. LDEQ will send notification of the final permit decision to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or a written request for notification of the final decision.
