LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (LDEQ)
NATIONAL OILWELL VARCO, LP
AMELIA COATING PLANT SOUTH
PROPOSED PART 70 AIR OPERATING PERMIT RENEWAL/MODIFICATION

The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, is accepting written comments on a proposed Part 70 air operating renewal/modification for National Oilwell Varco, L.P. , P. O. Box 1349, Amelia, LA 70341 for the Amelia Coating Plant South. **The facility is located at 2112 Hwy 662 North near Boeuf, Assumption Parish.**

National Oilwell Varco, LP requested renewal/modification of Part 70 Operating Permit No. 0200-00019-V1, issued on December 13, 1994.

In addition, the company is also requesting authorization for the following changes:

1. Increase the maximum and average short-term emission rates of several sources;
2. Increase hours of operation of several sources;
3. Add existing but currently non-permitted emission sources;
4. Shutdown permanently the outdoor abrasive blasting and associated diesel engine, Emission Point 24-97;
5. Remove the Hub City Internal Combustion Diesel Engine, the High Static Dust Collector, and the Powder Collector # 2, Emission Points 30-03IC, 22-96 and 29-03, respectively;
6. Provide better representation of on-site operations; and update the emission caps as well as the emissions calculations using the latest approved emission factors and/or calculation methods.

Written comments, written requests for a public hearing or written requests for notification of the final decision regarding this permit action may be submitted to LDEQ, Public Participation Group, P.O. Box 4313, Baton Rouge, LA 70821-4313. **Written comments and/or written requests must be received by 12:30 p.m., Thursday, May 12, 2011.** Written comments will be considered prior to a final permit decision.

If LDEQ finds a significant degree of public interest, a public hearing will be held. LDEQ will send notification of the final permit decision to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or a written request for notification of the final decision.

The permit application, proposed permit renewal/modification, and statement of basis are available for review at the LDEQ, Public Records Center, Room 127, 602 North 5th Street, Baton Rouge, LA.
