HUNT FOREST PRODUCTS INC
POLLOCK PLYWOOD MILL
PROPOSED PART 70 AIR OPERATING PERMIT MAJOR MODIFICATION
& PREVENTION OF SIGNIFICANT DETERIORATION (PSD) MODIFICATION

The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, is accepting written comments on the Proposed Part 70 Air Operating Permit Major Modification and PSD Modification for Hunt Forest Products, Inc., 1860 LA Hwy 524, Pollock, LA 71567, for their Pollock Plywood Mill. **The facility is located at 1860 LA Hwy 524, Pollock, Grant Parish.**

Hunt Forest Products, Inc. operates the Pollock Plywood Mill, a forest products mill producing plywood, wood veneer, wood chips and landscape timbers from pine timber.

Hunt Forest requested the following permit modifications:

- Replacement of the existing No. 2 Wood-Fired Boiler (11-89/EQT005) with an existing boiler, Boiler No. 3 (24-10/EQT 023) from Hunt's closed plywood mill in Natalbany, LA, to be installed with an electrostatic precipitator (ESP) for particulate control;
- Installation of additional heating zone sections to the Veneer Dryer No. 3 (10-89/ EQT010);
- An increase in the Veneer Dryer Cooling Zones Emissions CAP (20-04/GRP001) from 290 MMSF/yr to 340 MMSF/yr; and
- An increase in the Plywood Press CAP (23-10/GRP003) from 225 MMSF/yr to 270 MMSF/yr.

Written comments, written requests for a public hearing or written requests for notification of the final decision regarding this permit action may be submitted to LDEQ, Public Participation Group, P.O. Box 4313, Baton Rouge, LA 70821-4313. **Written comments and/or written requests must be received by 12:30 p.m., Monday, May 9, 2011.** Written comments will be considered prior to a final permit decision.

If LDEQ finds a significant degree of public interest, a public hearing will be held. LDEQ will send notification of the final permit decision to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or a written request for notification of the final decision.
