

PUBLIC NOTICE
LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (LDEQ)
PLAQUEMINES PARISH GOVERNMENT
DALCOUR WATER TREATMENT PLANT
DRAFT WATER DISCHARGE PERMIT

The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, is accepting written comments on a Louisiana Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (LPDES) permit prepared for the Plaquemines Parish Government, Dalcour Water Treatment Plant, 126 Sewer Plant Road, Belle Chasse, LA 70037. The facility is located **at 170 Water Plant Road in Braithwaite, Plaquemines Parish**. Upon the effective date of the final permit, the LPDES permit shall replace the previously issued LPDES permit.

The principal discharge from this source made into the Mississippi River via pipe and by pipe to Ray's Canal, thence to the levee ditch, thence to the Braithwaite Pumping Station, thence to the Big Marr, waters of the state classified for primary contact recreation, secondary contact recreation, limited aquatic life and wildlife use, drinking water supply, and oyster propagation. Under the SIC 4941, the applicant proposes to treat surface water to produce potable water, and to discharge sludge from the clarifier and settling basins and filter backwash.

During the preparation of this permit, it has been determined that the discharge will have no adverse impact on the existing uses of the receiving waterbody. As with any discharge, however, some change in existing water quality may occur.

Written comments, written requests for a public hearing or written requests for notification of the final decision regarding this permit action may be submitted to LDEQ, Public Participation Group, P.O. Box 4313, Baton Rouge, LA 70821-4313. **Written comments and/or written requests must be received by 12:30 p.m., Tuesday, May 3, 2011.** Written comments will be considered prior to a final permit decision.

If LDEQ finds a significant degree of public interest, a public hearing will be held. LDEQ will send notification of the final permit decision to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or a written request for notification of the final decision.

The application, draft permit and are available for review at the LDEQ, Public Records Center, Room 127, 602 North 5th Street, Baton Rouge, LA. Viewing hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday (except holidays). **The available information can also be accessed electronically on the Electronic Document Management System (EDMS) on the DEQ public website at www.deq.louisiana.gov.**
