PROPOSED PART 70 AIR OPERATING PERMIT RENEWAL AND MINOR MODIFICATION

The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, is accepting written comments on the proposed Part 70 air operating permit renewal and minor modification for Libbey Glass, Inc, P.O. Box 35000, Shreveport LA, 71130, for the Shreveport Plant. **The facility is located at 4302 Jewella Street, Shreveport, Caddo Parish.**

Libbey Glass, Inc's Shreveport Plant, a glass tableware manufacturing facility, requested to:

- Renew its Part 70 permit;
- Remove Decorating Lehrs #2 - #6 (EQTs 22-25 & 27), Decorating Spray Application Booth #1 and #2 (EQT 28 and EQT 29), Decorating Screen Room Operations (ARE 15), and Casso-Solar Drying Booth (ARE 18) from the permit; and
- Revise emissions associated with Decorating Lehr #1 (EQT 26). This lehr will be used to re-anneal glass products and will no longer be used to apply thermoplastic ceramic enamels to decorated glassware..

This permit was processed as an expedited permit in accordance with LAC 33:I.Chapter 18.

Box 4313, Baton Rouge, LA 70821-4313. **Written comments and/or written requests must be received by 12:30 p.m., Wednesday, May 11, 2011.** Written comments will be considered prior to a final permit decision.

If LDEQ finds a significant degree of public interest, a public hearing will be held. LDEQ will send notification of the final permit decision to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or a written request for notification of the final decision.
